



### **The feeding of baby lorikeets**

Your baby lorikeet should be fed a wet lorikeet mix fresh each day, and have dry lorikeet food in the cage as well.

Young birds should be protected from draughts.

All birds enjoy playing with bird toys.

Cuttlefish and shellgrit are also beneficial for your bird.

Worming your bird approximately every 3 months is also recommended.

Birds also enjoy special treats eg apple, pears, broccoli, peas/corn, grapes, kiwi fruit, spinach, orange, rockmelon, honeydew melon, watermelon, peaches apricots, nectarines etc.

Gum flowers, bottlebrush flowers, camellia flowers, hibiscus flowers your bird will enjoy. Just be careful that the plant/ flower is not poisonous

Do not feed chocolate, avocado and pineapple to your bird as it is harmful to them.
