



The feeding of baby sun conures, eclectus , alexandrine & Indian parrots

We recommend you feed your baby birds small parrot seed with extra sunflower seed while they are young birds. Until your bird settles into its new home it is advisable to put an extra bowl of seed on the bottom of the cage.

Young birds should be protected from draughts.

All birds enjoy playing with bird toys.

Cuttlefish and shellgrit are also beneficial for your bird.

Worming your bird approximately every 3 months is also recommended.

Birds also enjoy special treats eg seed treats, sweetcorn, peas, apple, broccoli, capsicum, grapes cucumber, zucchini, pear, kiwi fruit, raw beetroot, spinach, orange, tomato, celery, carrot.

These birds also enjoy nuts:- roasted peanuts in the shell, almonds, walnuts etc.

Do not feed chocolate, avocado and pineapple to your bird as it is harmful to them.
